  - o Students should dress appropriately to move, dance, and run comfortably. We recommend that you wear closed-toed shoes.
  - o Once scripts have been distributed please bring them each day.
- **Final Performance**: If you will not be here on Saturday, the day of the performance, please let us know within the first two days of class. This way, we will be able to plan for the performance and accommodate your needs.
  - o Students should wear their Playmaker's T-Shirt for the performance with either a black or dark jean bottom.

- **Homework**: Plan on rehearsing on your own after class. The faster the students get memorized, the more we can play!
